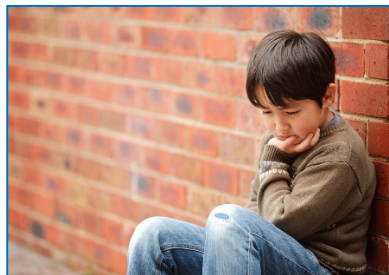


The Howard County Family Institute presents
