



# Proposed Redistricting Recommendations for 2018–19

## A Summary for Families of Elementary and Middle School Students

On October 3, Interim Superintendent Michael Martirano presented the Board of Education with his proposed recommendations to address overcrowding in HCPSS schools. As a parent of an elementary or middle school student included in the proposal, your family may be affected by the attendance area adjustments. We want to provide you with some details of the proposal as well as information on contacting the Board of Education. The Board will hold a series of work sessions and offer public hearings and other opportunities for community input. The Board of Education's decision is expected on Thursday, November 16, 2017.

### ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

■ **Redistrict 1,922 students to fill Elementary School #42 and bring 37 elementary schools below or within maximum capacity.**

The planned Fall 2018 opening of Elementary School #42 provides an opportunity to relieve elementary overcrowding in the eastern part of the county. The recommendations would also balance capacity utilization across elementary schools in the Columbia area and the northern part of the county.

Over the long term, we will achieve further progress by opening Elementary School #43 in 2023, replacing Talbott Springs Elementary School, and through initiatives such as regional immersion centers for languages, performing arts or STEM.

### MIDDLE SCHOOLS

■ **Limited redistricting of 313 students to address feeder patterns.**

The proposed redistricting for middle schools moves approximately 300 students to create more consistent feeder patterns that align with the elementary school recommendations.

Over the longer term, we will achieve further progress through the redistricting related to the opening of High School #13, and through initiatives such as a planned middle/high school career development center.
