

BSAP SMA Virtual Fall 2020 Program

This year, the Black Student Achievement Program's (BSAP) Saturday Math Academy (SMA) will offer a virtual program for Howard County Public School System students in all levels of math for grades 3-12.

Registration will take place on line **Saturday, September 26th** from 9:00am to 12noon. Class space is limited.

Sessions will take place on Saturdays from 9 -12noon on the following dates:

- Saturday, October 10
- Saturday, October 17
- Saturday, October 24
- Saturday, October 31
- Saturday, November 7
- Saturday, November 14 (*No scheduled class*)
- Saturday, November 21

Program fee: \$80.00 Students qualified for FARMs fee: \$40.00

Parents who register their child(ren) for the program in HCPSS Connect are **requesting** enrollment. Notification will be emailed to parents whose child(ren)'s request was accepted. Acceptance in the program will be based on a first come first served basis and available space in the specified class.

Parents whose child(ren)'s request is accepted will receive information regarding payment through MySchoolBucks (4% Service Fee). A student is not enrolled in the program until the program fee is paid. If payment is not received by the requested date, the child's enrollment will be forfeited.

Students whose request was not accepted due to space will be notified.

Parents whose child(ren) is enrolled in the program will receive an invitation to a virtual Parent Orientation on **Saturday, October 3rd**. from 12noon to 1:00pm.
