# What Does Math Look Like This Year?

- 75 minutes daily
- Begins with a high-quality number routine
- Standards based instruction: high quality tasks, variety of representations, purposeful questions, and student discourse
- Closure everyday

# Differentiated Math Instruction

- Set instructional outcomes that are challenging and rigorous for all students
- Select tasks with multiple entry points
- Intentional selection of daily structure of math block based on student needs
- Encourage students to use varied strategies to make sense of task using their own reasoning
- Flexible groupings

# What Does ELA Look Like This Year?

- 2 hours a day - Reading & Writing
- Opens with whole group standards-based instruction
- Students work independently and in small instructional groups
- Reflection to close reading and writing
- Differentiated bi-weekly spelling lists

# Primary English Language Arts

- The Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark system is used to identify students' reading levels in Grades K-2
- Students meet in small groups to match instruction to their level
- Flexible grouping
- Independent student practice includes: Read to Self, Read to Someone, Listen to Reading, Word Work, Work on Writing

# Homework Expectations

## HCPSS Grades Pre-K – 2 Guidelines:

- **Amount of Homework:** No more than 20 minutes of homework per night will be assigned. In Pre-K and Kindergarten there will be no assignments that must be submitted to the teacher.
- **Purpose of Homework:** Homework provides practice opportunities for skill development.
  - Families are encouraged to read to or with their children nightly.
- Families are encouraged to practice grade appropriate math facts or related activities on a nightly basis.

## Our Team's Homework Expectations:

- Each day students will use their agenda book to write down their homework. The agenda book is also another way to relay information.
- Math Homework will consist of two nights of basic math fact practice and two review assignments. These should not take longer than 10 minutes as they are review. Please let me know if your child is having difficulty completing the homework.
- Reading Homework will be at least 10 minutes of reading per night. An adult needs to sign the agenda book when the reading is complete.

- Students will participate in **Afternoon** Meeting this year to develop classroom community and key social skills such as cooperation, assertion, responsibility, empathy, and self-control.
- Components include: Greeting, Share, Activity, Message

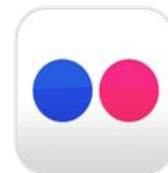

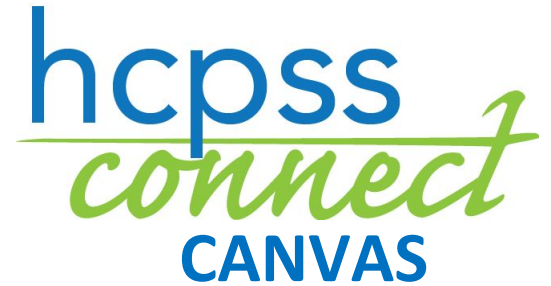
