Arrival & Dismissal Procedures

Safety is our first priority during arrival & dismissal. We also strive to make this process as efficient as possible. Please review the procedures below to help ensure the safety of our students, staff, & families.



DRES Car Loop & Parking Procedures

- Vehicles will proceed past our school, turn around in Waterloo Park & drive back down Old Waterloo Road to enter our car loop line.
- **PLEASE** do not make any U-turns on Old Waterloo Road.
- Drop off **ONLY** in the designated pull-off area.
- Staff will guide you to the correct drop off location.
- All vehicles must stay in the car loop line and move forward when directed by a staff member.
- Students should stay in car with family until 9:05 AM.
- There is no passing of other vehicles during this time.
- Students should exit the vehicles on the passenger side of the car only.
- Please follow directions from staff members when driving near crosswalks and the car loop.
- Do not enter the bus loop/parking lots during arrival & dismissal.
- Please be sure to use the crosswalk at all times. We want to model safe behavior for our students!
- During the hours of arrival and departure, all traffic entering the bus loop will follow one-way directions (enter through bus loop, exit through parking lot)

Arrival & Dismissal Times:

- 9:05 – Staff Reports for AM Duty
- 9:10 – Students Enter Building
- 9:10 - 9:25 Breakfast
- 9:25 – Late Bell /
Instruction Begins
- 3:55 – Bus Riders / Walkers dismissed
- 3:55 – All vehicles/day care vans must be in car loop line.

Many DRES students are walkers. Please be patient, cautious, & keep an eye out for our students on Old Waterloo Road, side streets, intersections, & crosswalks.

There is no parking allowed directly alongside DRES or in our Bus Loop between 8:30 – 9:30 AM & 3:15 – 4:15 PM.



Car Loop Tags will be provided to each family vehicle that is used to pick up students during dismissal. These tags attach to your rearview mirror and help ensure student safety & efficiency. Please ask a DRES staff member if you are in need of an additional or replacement Car Loop Tag.
