Laptops

Illness

Covid Like Symptoms

COVID-like symptoms are defined as any <u>ONE</u> of the following:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Sore throat
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- New onset of severe headache (especially with fever)
- New loss of taste or smell



Any student with one of these symptoms needs to go home and first be tested, if permission is granted by parents.

*For persons with chronic conditions such as asthma, the symptoms should represent a change from baseline
