Attendance

- Come to school every day—on time—doors open at 9:10, you must be here by 9:25
- Stay home—fever, vomiting, bad cold/cough
- Bring a note when you return
- On-time!

Safe and Supportive School Environment

- Safe, engaging, and supportive school climate
- No behaviors that interfere with or threaten the physical, emotional, mental, or academic well being of students or staff
- [Code of Conduct](#)
- Clean school—inside and out, keep it that way, keep feet and hands off the walls, trash in trash cans
- Eating in the classroom—only at breakfast and K snack
- Bathrooms—clean and safe
- No alcohol, drugs, tobacco

Civility

- Kind and civil to each other—adults and peers
- Respectful
- Helpful
- Cooperative
- Honest—tell the truth, no stealing from staff or students

Bullying

- We are polite and kind, we are not rude, mean, or unkind
- May include: hitting, kicking, shoving, spitting, hair pulling, throwing things, getting another person to hurt someone, teasing, name-calling, threatening, rude, intimidation, spreading rumors, gossiping, cyberbullying
- Need to tell an adult ASAP
- This will not be tolerated—very serious!
- All reports will be investigated

Student Assault on Staff

- Teachers work very hard
- Respect
- May not yell at, put hands on, throw things—at a teacher/staff

Weapons

- None!
- Weapons include: knives, guns, school materials used as a weapon
- If we receive a report, you may be searched
- No toys

Discrimination

- Include all
- Treat all equally—no matter boy/girl, brown skin/white skin, tall/short, different reading or math groups, etc

Grading/Reporting

- Do your best every day
- Do homework and turn it in
- You earn your grades

Dress Code

- Wear safe shoes—PE and Recess—sneakers—no flip flops or high heels
- Tops that cover you, appropriate words on a shirt
- Shorts—appropriate length
- Please keep track of your clothes (lost and found)
- No make-up, we are in elementary school
- Hats/hoodies worn at appropriate times
- No costumes

Medication

- Parents should call to arrange.

Responsible Use of Technology
